

Episode 034-The New Student

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(the episode begins in Lock and Tino's room, Breta is with them as well, they are watching a shopping channel on tv)

Female Host: This fantastic silverware will look great on any dinner table.

Lock: There's one thing I don't understand...

Breta: (whispering to Tino) Only one thing?

(Tino snickers)

Lock: How come a dinner table is called that because really you eat every meal there?

(Tino and Breta look at each other before they stare at him)

Tino: Um, I think it's because dinner table sounds fine, and no one really cares anyway.

Lock: I care, it should be called the "food table"...now that would make sense.

Tino: (sarcastically) Why don't you make a petition?

Lock: Here's another thing I was wondering about. This one really keeps me up late thinking...

Breta: Brace yourself Tino, there's no telling where this will lead us.

Lock: You know how dogs all have different personalities? Like how some are more energetic than others? Could there ever be a dog that was like a vegetarian or an evil murderer or something? You know, some dog that's personality was just really unusual?

(Breta and Tino just look at him even more bewildered)

Breta: I think God gave you a defective brain, Lock.

Tino: I don't know Breta, my theory is God was bored and gave Lock a monkey's brain for some amusement.

Lock: (picking his hair) Hey! I'm not a monkey!

(he picks something out of his hair and eats it as Breta and Tino shake their heads and go back to watching tv)

Female Host: These incredible earrings were once one-hundred dollars, but through our membership package you can get them for only four easy payments of twenty-four, ninety-nine! Isn't shopping fun?

Male Host: Let's take our first call...hello, you're on the air.

Lady: Hi there, I just ordered the earrings, their lovely. I'm planning on getting some for all my friends as well.

Female Host: That's fantastic, I know you'll enjoy them.

Lady: Yes, their perf-

(she is cut off as her husband grabs the phone)

Husband: Damn you home shopping! Stop selling my wife all these things, you're making me broke!

Female Host: Umm...

(the couple is heard yelling and arguing over the phone, eventually a bunch of smacks are heard as the hosts listen on with horror)

Male Host: Um, that's it for calls right now, thanks for watching and make sure to buy the rest of our wonderful stuff!

(Lock turns the tv off)

Lock: (sarcastically) Oh yeah, I wanna get married real soon.

(Breta sighs when she hears that)

Breta: You know Lock, not all women just spend their husband's money.

Lock: Really?

Breta: Oh yeah, of course...(stopping then bursting into laughter) sorry, I was never good at lying.

(Lock glares at her)

Tino: Where's Juzan? He said he'd let me take another shot at impressing some girls with his book of pickup lines.

Breta: Hmm...my women's intuition is telling me that he's somewhere with girls right now.

Lock: That's not women's intuition, that's just playing the odds. Ninety-nine percent of his day is spent hanging around a girl or two.

(the scene goes to the hallway where Juzan watches a few cheerleaders walk by, once they pass by he tosses his lucky hat near them)

Juzan: Damn, I dropped my lucky hat. Could one of you ladies please get it for me?

Maxi: Sure, no problem.

(to Juzan's delight she bends over, picks it up, and hands it to him)

Juzan: Thanks so much. My name's Juzan, but you can just call me the black stallion.

Maxi: Wow, you're that guy everyone talks about. I always overhear girls saying how talented you are in martial arts, not to mention how handsome you are.

Juzan: Guilty as charged, so what's your name?

Maxi: Maxi, and this is Arin and Cliea. (they blush and say hi)

Juzan: Nice to meet you lovely ladies. I'm in room thirty-three, you should come by sometime and hang out, I've got a single.

Maxi: I'd like that. Since this is my first year here, I don't really know many people.

Juzan: I'm the only guy you need to know.

Maxi: Hey, have you heard about the rumor going around school?

Juzan: The answer is yes, I did save all those kids from a burning orphanage.

Maxi: No, some pervert drilled a few holes into our changing room and was trying to peep us.

Juzan: (trying not to look suspicious) The beast! I'll tell you what, maybe I should stand guard where those holes are to make sure the peeping tom never gets another chance? You can all trust me...I have nothing but complete respect for a woman's privacy.

Maxi: That's so sweet of you Juzan. So you really rescued all those orphans?

Juzan: (grinning) As sure as I have respect for a woman's privacy.

(the scene goes back to the other heroes in Lock and Tino's room)

Lock: I'm really worried about Master Musa, she's been gone for a week now. There's no way one meeting could have taken so long.

Tino: Yeah, something's definitely not right with that.

Breta: I agree. Besides, didn't she initially say she'd only be gone a few days?

Lock: I also want her to come back so Ms. Hancock won't be our substitute anymore, she's such a mean teacher.

Tino: Hey you think this is tough? When Musa took you into isolated training last semester we had to suffer with Ms. Hancock as our teacher for three months. It was brutal.

Lock: Yeah but at least you didn't have to spar with her. I don't think she's familiar with the term "pulling your punches", I get new bruises every day against her.

Breta: What time is it?

Tino: (looking at a clock) Twelve thirty-four.

Breta: You guys wanna get some lunch?

Lock: Sure, that will give us even more time to talk about that dog personality question.

Breta: (sarcastically) Great.

(they head out, but find a lot of commotion in the hallway, a lot people have gathered around)

Breta: What's all this?

Tino: No clue.

Lock: (to a student) Hey, what's going on? Did Master Musa come back or something?

Student: It's no biggie, just some new student moving in.

Tino: New student?

(the scene then shows Hanzo)

Hanzo: So, this is Ozana School huh? What a dump.

(he starts to walk down the hallway, not paying any attention to any of the other students, except when he walks by Lock. The two meet eyes as Hanzo walks by.)

Tino: So that's the new guy?

Breta: Did you get a load of his eyes? They were pitch black! How freaky.

Tino: Yeah, I feel bad for whoever ends up rooming with him.

(the scene switches to Juzan sitting in his room, using a computer, all of a sudden Hanzo enters)

Juzan: Uhh, who are you?

Hanzo: Apparently your new roommate.

Juzan: Oh, well I'm Juzan, nice to meet-

Hanzo: (cutting him off) I have two rules. Rule number one, never talk to me or get in my way, rule number two, always obey rule number one.

Juzan: (annoyed) Tss, whatever.

(he angrily leaves as Hanzo begins to unpack, the scene then shows the four main heroes eating lunch)

Lock: So what do you think Juzan?

Juzan: That's honestly the stupidest thing you've ever said Lock, dogs having weird personalities, give me a break.

Tino: I told you he'd find it stupid Lock.

Lock: You guys will all be sorry when I prove it by finding a vegetarian dog!

Breta: Weekends are so boring here, there's nothing to do.

Juzan: Only for someone like you who doesn't know how to find the good in any situation, I made myself a little home entertainment system in front of the girls changing room.

Lock: I thought you said Ms. Hancock caught you though?

Breta: I'm glad she did, Juzan. Every time I have to change in there I'm looking over my shoulder every two seconds. Besides, the girls know someone has been trying to look at them and Ms. Hancock said she'd make an example out of the next guy who tried to peep.

Juzan: Ms. Hancock only caught me that one time though, she won't do it again. I fixed the wall so next time I just need to be more careful.

Tino: You fixed it? Um, I just remembered...I've got some things to do...

(he gets up and leaves)

Juzan: (to Breta) How come you make a big deal when I try to look but you don't say anything to him?

Breta: I don't have to, my women's intuition is telling me the situation will resolve itself.

(Tino leaves the lunchroom as Hanzo enters)

Breta: Hey, look. There's that guy again.

Juzan: He's my roommate now. This sucks.

Breta: Oh yeah? What's he like?

Juzan: A jerk.

Breta: (smiling) That's karma for trying to peep the girls.

Juzan: (sarcastically) Ha-ha, very funny. I bet this is Ms. Hancock's doing, she knew how much I wanted a single and is doing everything she can to make my life miserable.

Lock: What's your roommate's name?

Juzan: No idea, we didn't exactly hit it off great.

Lock: He's probably just a bit shy because he's new. Let's see if he wants to sit with us.

(Hanzo walks by with his food tray)

Lock: Hey, you wanna sit with us?

(Hanzo walks right past him and sits alone at an empty table)

Breta: I see what you mean, Juzan.

(the scene goes to Tino, he's at the spot where Juzan drilled the holes)

Tino: Lookie lookie I'm gonna see some nookie! Oh yeah!

(the second he looks in a large net drops on him and a bunch of angry cheerleaders come out)

Maxi: We heard a rumor there was some pervert trying to look at us!

Tino: Wait, you've got the wrong guy!

Cheerleader 2: Enough talk, let's get him girls!

(they all pummel him as the scene goes back to the lunchroom, three students approach Hanzo)

Student 1: Hey, you're sitting in our spot.

(Hanzo continues to eat and doesn't even acknowledge them)

Student 2: Well, looks like someone's got a little attitude problem. You better watch out, we're the best in the intermediate class, so you better not mess with us.

Hanzo: (still not looking at them) Get lost.

Student 1: Fine, if that's the way you're going to be I'll make you move!

(he tries a punch, but while taking a sip of his drink with his right arm, Hanzo blocks the hit with his left forearm, elbows the student, then backhands him all in one motion while still drinking with his right arm, sending him flying as Lock and the others watch on)

Juzan: Wow, did you guys see that?

Breta: Yeah, maybe we should go over there and set that guy straight, I won't let him bully people around here.

Lock: No, stay here. In all honesty those others started it.

(the two remaining students are in shock. One of them gets mad and spits in Hanzo's food. Hanzo looks really ticked off and with a yell and an explosion sends the other two flying into their friend on the ground. Hanzo walks by and dumps his tray on them as he leaves. The scene switches to the cheerleaders, who are dragging Tino in the net to Ms. Hancock's office, they knock on the door and Ms. Hancock comes out.)

Ms. Hancock: What do you want?

Maxi: We caught the peeping tom! (she gives Tino a kick)

Cheerleader 2: He's even uglier than we imagined.

Ms. Hancock: Tino, I'm surprised at you. Leave him to me girls, I'll take care of him. Go tell the janitor to repair the wall.

Maxi: Okay, thanks.

(the cheerleaders leave)

Tino: I'm innocent I swear!

Ms. Hancock: (holding the net up) I was hoping Juzan would be the one who got caught but no matter, I'll send a message to him and any other pervert by making an example out of you.

(she throws Tino into her office and begins to enter when the three students Hanzo beat up run over to her)

Student 1: Hey, Ms. Hancock, you've got to help us!

Ms. Hancock: What's the matter?

Student 1: We were just jumped by some student. This guy should be expelled he attacked us all!

Ms. Hancock: Do any of you know his name?

(they hesitate as none of them know his name, until they see Hanzo walking down the hallway)

Student 3: There he is, that's the guy!

Ms. Hancock: Are you sure?

Student 2: Yes, positive.

Ms. Hancock: Alright. (to Hanzo) Hey you, get over here!

Hanzo: Are you talking to me?

Ms. Hancock: Yes I'm talking to you, now get over here!

(Lock, Juzan, and Breta notice Hanzo and the students with Ms. Hancock, the three students run away when they see him coming)

Juzan: Hey look, maybe she'll beat this guy up?

Ms. Hancock: Did you attack those three students?

Hanzo: If by attack you mean put them in their place then yes I did, but who the hell wants to know?

Ms. Hancock: Ms. Hancock, that's who. And watch your mouth kid.

Hanzo: (puzzled) Handco-

Ms. Hancock: No! It's *Hancock*, not that! Why does every single guy get that wrong. It's like you all have one track minds or something.

Hanzo: Well, I don't really care what your name is. So unless you want that pretty face of yours ruined I suggest you stay out of my way.

Ms. Hancock: Oh, you must be that transfer student Headmaster Ozana was telling me about, so you missed my introduction. I'm the school's disciplinarian and unless you apologize, you'll be in a world of pain!

Hanzo: A female disciplinarian? What do you do, nag people into submission?

(Hanzo snickers and Lock finds that funny as well)

Lock: Hehehehe, nag them into submission, that's a good one. Hehehe.

(Ms. Hancock notices Lock laughing and gives him an evil look which quickly makes him stop, she then turns her attention back to Hanzo)

Ms. Hancock: Oh you're just asking to get hurt.

Hanzo: Better fighters have tried, believe me.

Tino: (thinking) Now's my chance, I've got to make a break for it while she's distracted or else I'm dead!

(Ms. Hancock and Hanzo seem about to fight when she notices Tino slipping out of the net and running away)

Ms. Hancock: Get back here Tino! (turning back to Hanzo) You're just lucky I've got to deal with him first. Now wait here until I get back.

(she charges her aura and races after Tino)

Hanzo: (thinking) A silver aura? Who would have thought I'd find such a strong power in such a weakling school? I don't think I want to fight someone like that right now...I'll wait for a better opportunity.

(he walks by Lock, Juzan and Breta without looking at them)

Juzan: Something's unsettling about that guy.

Lock: Yeah.

Juzan: (sarcastically to Breta) So, is your women's intuition picking up anything on him?

Breta: I see pain and fear...no wait, that's for Tino.

(the scene changes to Tino beaten down on the ground, Ms. Hancock's foot on his head)

Ms. Hancock: Did you really think you could run from me!?

Tino: (wearily) Mercy.

Ms. Hancock: (picking him up by the throat) This is just the beginning.

(she drags him off as the scene changes to Juzan's room, Hanzo is sitting on his bed, meditating, Juzan is sitting on his bed glaring at Hanzo)

Juzan: (thinking) Who is this guy, where did he transfer from?

(Juzan takes out a bag of potato chips and starts eating while looking through a magazine, the sound of the chips opening and then Juzan chewing on them annoys

Hanzo, and he opens one eye to glare at Juzan, who puts the bag away. As Hanzo goes back to meditating some girls enter.)

Maxi: Hey Juzan, we just got that new dance cd.

Juzan: Great, put it in.

Girl 2: Who's that?

Juzan: Oh, he's my new roommate. (to Hanzo) Hey, how bout saying hello?

(Hanzo doesn't respond and turns his back to them all)

Juzan: (sighing) Oh well, never mind him. Let's just hear the cd.

Maxi: By the way, we caught the peeping tom. Ms. Hancock's probably beating him up right now.

Juzan: That's good news.

Girl 3: We also had the wall repaired and a security camera put in so it will never happen again.

Juzan: (thinking) That's not good news.

(the girls hands the small cd to Juzan who plays it, they all start dancing. Hanzo continues to meditate but struggles against the loud music.)

Hanzo: (thinking) Focus, a true warrior should be able to block out any outside distractions...no matter how ridiculously annoying they may be.

(as Juzan and the girls continue to dance, Juzan notices Hanzo's annoyance and turns the volume up even more. Hanzo finally cannot stand it anymore and turning around, he blows up the stereo, Juzan and the girls are shocked)

Juzan: Hey! I'm going to teach you a lesson.

Hanzo: Just try it.

(it looks like Juzan is about to fight Hanzo, until all of a sudden a voice is heard on the loud speaker)

Voice: Attention, would Hanzo and Juzan please report to the main arena so that Hanzo's skills can be evaluated for class selection?

Juzan: (thinking) So, Hanzo's his name. (to the girls) Don't worry babes, I'll be back in no time. This won't take long.

Hanzo: (smirking) Heh.

Maxi: We'll come watch, after all, I've heard what a great fighter you are. I can't wait to see you in action.

Juzan: Sure, I'll put on a show for you all.

(as Juzan and Hanzo leave and head to the main arena, many students who also heard the announcement enter the main arena to watch, Lock, Breta, and a bruised Tino catch up with Juzan)

Breta: So you get to have the first crack at him, Juzan?

Juzan: Believe me, I won't hold anything back. He's only been here one damn day and I'm already sick of him. I'm gonna make this guy look like such a fool in front of everyone, just you wait.

(he starts to head down)

Lock: (stopping Juzan) Keep your guard up.

Juzan: What? Why? You don't think this guy is actually strong do you?

Lock: I'm not sure. All I know is he wasn't surprised when he saw Ms. Hancock's aura (quick flashback of that), most people are in awe when seeing spirit energy for the first time so he must know about it already.

Juzan: Oh come on, I'm a blue aura fighter, even if he does what's he gonna do to me?

(he heads down)

Tino: You know, I wonder what the tournament is gonna be like this year. I mean since Lock's got a red aura now I wonder if there's any chance someone else could beat him.

Breta: I doubt it, no one on Drakon's team was that strong last year.

(Juzan enters the ring, where Hanzo is waiting, Ms. Hancock, Headmaster Ozana, and the rest of the teachers are standing off to the side to evaluate Hanzo)

Headmaster Ozana: Alright, since Hanzo was a transfer student and missed the initial sparring test, he needs to go against his roommate so we can see which class to place him in.

Ms. Hancock: Are you sure having him matched with Juzan is a good idea? Juzan's the second best in the entire school, maybe Hanzo should fight an intermediate student to get a better look at his skills.

Headmaster Ozana: Nonsense, our school policy is transfer students must face their roommate.

Maxi: Go Juzan! Wipe the floor with him!

Cheerleader 2: You're the best!

Cheerleader 3: We love you Juzan!

(in the ring, both Hanzo and Juzan are staring each other down, both look confident)

Breta: This Hanzo guy gives me the creeps, he's just staring at Juzan with those freakish eyes.

(Juzan walks up to Hanzo, the two are face to face)

Juzan: You don't scare me at all.

Hanzo: You have no idea what you're up against.

Headmaster Ozana: Ready...

(Hanzo and Juzan get into stances, they are only a few feet apart from each other)

Headmaster Ozana: Now, begin!

(Hanzo does a leg sweep that Juzan jumps over, but as Hanzo comes around he kicks Juzan in the stomach, who braces his fall with a hand-plant and jumps back a few steps, all the other students are very surprised)

Juzan: So, you're not so bad after all. But no more playing around, feel my true power!

(Juzan charges his aura and flies at Hanzo at full speed, charging a fist, a second before he punches Hanzo, Hanzo smirks and warps away from the punch. Juzan is confused and turns his head only to get a very hard kick in the face that knocks him down very hard, and when Hanzo lands, a red aura is glowing around his body, everyone is stunned.)

Maxi: (fearfully) Juzan!

Lock: (shocked) Ahh! He's got a red aura too!

Breta: No way! I can't believe it!

Ms. Hancock: (thinking) Unreal, no student has ever started at this level. I guess it's safe to say he's in the advanced class.

(the episode ends with Juzan on the ground as Hanzo turns to stare down Lock as the episode ends)
